## **Launch**

Read Isaiah 6:1-8 ('Isaiah's Commission')

#### **Explore**

- 1) Verses 1-4 describe how Isaiah saw God. Take a few moments to read through the verses and talk together as a group about how you see God.
- 2) In verse 1 the bible tell us that God is seated on a throne. What does that mean to you? Can you think of other things / people in our lives who we tend to place on a throne, and perhaps need to consider replacing them with God?
- 3) God is a Holy God, he is also a loving approachable father and full of grace and love for us. How do you think we can balance both aspects of God?
- 4) What are the areas personal you to where you feel you may need to re-balance?

## **Apply**

- 1) Isaiah recognised how he compared to a Holy God.
  In what ways do you see the holiness of God?
  How can you use this to help you see how Holy God is?
- 2) The book of Isaiah is also known as the book of salvation. Where can you see Jesus is this scripture?

#### **Pray**

Let's pray for the following:

- that we would see more of the Holiness of God in scripture,
- that we would quickly deal with sin
- that we would listen for God to tell us where he wants us to serve...and that we would go!
